Thank you for your interest in our **NSW pre licensing course, Statement of attainment from Certificate II Security Operations** course.

Courses are held at our Fairfield Training Centre, level 2, Suite 7, No 1 The Crescent, Fairfield, across from the Fairfield Hotel. Entrance is off Hamilton Road.

Course duration for a 1A/1G/1C is ten days, Monday - Friday (2 weeks) consecutively.

The cost of a 1A/1G/1C Security course is \$650 per person.

If you require a **Senior First Aid Certificate** (*which is a pre-requisite when applying for a Security Licence*) and a **Responsible Service of Alcohol Certificate** (*required for working in licensed premises*) the total cost is \$775. (Senior First Aid and RSA will be provided by the RTO HOSTEC and held on Saturdays.

To apply:

- Complete the enclosed application form
- Read "Fact sheet 6" available on the home page of our website
- Complete in full a "P1016" also available on our website homepage
- Return both "P1016" and application form to our office, in person or by fax or post (details below)
- with one of the following documents:

Certified copy of an Australian Birth Certificate OR
Certificate of Australian Citizenship
Certificate of Evidence Resident Status (Form 283) OR
Certified copy of Australian Driver's Licence

For New Zealand applicants:

Certified copy of your passport, showing passport number, name & date of birth, issue & expiry date, and photograph is required.
Certified copy of visa page, clearly showing Immigration Australia stamp with date of arrival in Australia

NB: All applicants must be Australian Citizens or a Permanent Resident of Australia

All applicants must undertake a Language, Literacy and Numeric assessment before commencing training; competency will determine suitability to continue on training. This is a legal requirement.

The results of this test will be stored and may be shared with the SLED (Security Licensing and Enforcement Directorate)

How do you get a full unrestricted licence?

When you start work with a security company, you will have to continue your training for 12 months in order to gain the qualifications needed to be eligible to apply for a full unrestricted security licence.

The Security Licensing and Enforcement Directorate requires you to work for a period of 12 months in the capacity of your Provisional Licence class and complete the additional training requirements in order to apply for the full unrestricted licence.

The additional training you undertake will depend on what class of licence you want to gain but will be at either a Certificate II or Certificate III level.

How does the unrestricted training take place?

Most of your training will be done on the job but you will also be required to attend some classroom training and undertake assessments that may be on the job, in a classroom with other guards or by working on your own to complete assignments or projects.

Your employer may pay for this training or you may be eligible for a traineeship. In this case the NSW Government will subsidise your employer for the training and you will not have to pay.

If you are not eligible for a traineeship you will be required to pay for any additional training. Your trainer will help you to determine whether you are able to receive a traineeship.
